

## AMHERST TRIUMPHS, 26-6

### Lord Jeffs Rally Strongly After Rochester Scores First

ROCHESTER, N. Y., Sept. 25 (AP)—Amherst took to the air today to humble the University of Rochester, 26 to 6, before 6,000 fans in the season's football opener for both teams.

The Yellow Jackets scored in the opening period when Halfback Dick Eden skirted right end for 24 yards. The try for point was blocked.

The Lord Jeffs rolled 66 yards in the second, Ivar Rosendale going over from the 11. A 22-yard Lew Hammond to Jack Jordan pass helped the drive. The kick was blocked. Hammond passed to Jordan near the end of the second for a touchdown, the play covering 53 yards. Rosendale's placement made it 13—6.

Amherst drove for a touchdown from its 44 in the third period, Jim Rousch scoring on a buck following two completed passes. The kick was no good. The last-period score was made on a pass from Dave Gold to End Andy Scholtz. Jordan booted the point.
